Dakota joined Dr. Krupp's family when she was just 6 weeks old as a foster puppy. She quickly became a foster failure due to her sweet personality and sweet face! When Dr. Krupp is not at work, you may find her with Dakota hiking, exploring new areas or relaxing by the beach.





Keeper is an 11 year old Collie who came to us for the recent development of teeth chattering. He was otherwise a happy senior dog who continued to eat well. Upon exam, Keeper was found to have significant dental disease. His 2 large upper chewing teeth on both sides also had an obvious infection surrounding them. Keeper had a dental procedure scheduled for the following week and was found to have *tooth root abscesses* on those upper teeth.



Tooth root abscesses occur when a tooth's enamel is damaged and bacteria are allowed to enter the pulp cavity. Enamel is commonly damaged throughout a dog's life through play and chewing on hard surfaces or toys. Keeper had 11 extractions that day, including the two abscessed teeth. He did wonderfully under anesthesia and has returned to his normal, healthy self. Now he needs to learn a new trick...brushing his remaining teeth!
