MONTHLY PATIENT SPOTLIGHT: A “SIMPLE” PROBLEM NEEDS EXTRA CARE!



Corneal (eye) ulcers are a common cause of eye pain in dogs and often heal quickly with medication – but sometimes they need a little extra attention. One of our patients, Belle, came to us with a watery, irritated eye that didn't improve as expected. With additional testing, we identified a type of corneal ulcer that required a minor procedure to help the eye heal properly. With the right treatment, Belle's comfort was restored and her eye healed beautifully.

If you notice any concern with your pet's eyes, we encourage you to schedule an appointment sooner rather than later. Prompt evaluation helps prevent discomfort, protects vision, and allows us to address problems before they become more serious.
